I never could bear him - Now as to the what and when we are going when this Civil war is over, I hardly know how to answer you - I have had an idea for some time, that if we worked along and kept in the Army Corps for the defences of Washington, that after a while the heavy fighting would be over and we should camp some where in this vicinity and spend the last part of our term of three years very quietly, and then I was going to fix one up a nice little
